


# WE'RE STARTING A SEED LIBRARY!

## 1 Control your own food supply

Strengthen your local food system and increase food security - all while saving money! The most basic act of defense against the corporate control of our seeds is to save seeds and distribute them to others.

Support the agricultural heritage of Huntersville and the surrounding areas for over 150 years. Promote local agriculture over time by growing local seeds that are adapted to the region.

Grow your community while learning how to save seeds and connecting to our collective history of seed as a shared public resource. Foster a culture of sharing and abundance by offering access to seed for all.

Preserving seed lineages and biodiversity of our local region.

Seeds are very adaptable and will gradually adjust to the conditions where they are grown. The more people save seeds in a specific community, the more adapted to that area the seeds become. The seed library contributes to heirlooms and developing strains that are unique to our community.
